City Coordinator Responsibilities

City Coordinators serve as a 'watchmen' for their community.

Jeremiah 29:7, Ezekiel 3:16

The City Coordinator volunteer position exists to pray for, coordinate with and support the citywide prayer efforts of churches, pastor networks and prayer ministries throughout the year. As needed, the City Coordinator will facilitate the planning and execution of regularly scheduled citywide prayer gatherings (weekly, bi-monthly or monthly). This position is also responsible for assuring there is at least one city or community event on the first Thursday in May in support of the National Day of Prayer. The City Coordinator may also lead the city in periodic prayer gatherings when there are national days of fasting and prayer or in times of difficulties/tragedies. This position will best be served through a team of people working with the City Coordinator.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

1. Encourage/Mobilize people to Pray

- Assure that the city is covered in prayer in the north, south, east & west throughout the year by recruiting and encouraging people to lead citywide prayer gatherings throughout the year especially on the National Day of Prayer.
- Encourage people to participate in ReUnion WatchNet by registering for a prayer watch that they can fulfill from home or in a public setting.

2. Establish working relationships with among the 7 Centers of influence

- Identify who the key people are in the city in the 7 centers of influence and make personal contact with them to share the vision for 7x24 prayer coverage. The Seven Centers include Family, Church, Business, Arts/Entertainment/Sports, Government, Education, and Military.
- Maintain contact with the key people throughout the year and have them participate in and lead periodic citywide prayer events

3. Coordinate and support local prayer efforts - year round

- Establish relationships with the leaders of prayer ministries, prayer networks, marketplace ministries, pastor's networks and church prayer leaders within the city and gather them together for regular times of prayer.
- Support the promotion of local prayer gatherings by getting them posted on the ReUnion WatchNet website.
- Develop a relationship with these organizations by attending their meetings, sharing the vision for 7x24 prayer coverage, providing prayer support and participating in their prayer ministries when and where appropriate.
- Pray for those who lead ministries and are intercessors for the city.
